




FIG.2- MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE FORWARD SURGE CURRENT 50 PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT. (A) 40 8.3ms Single Half Sine Wave 30 JEDEC Method 20 10 0 2 10 20 40 60 80 100 6 8 NUMBER OF CYCLES AT 60Hz

FIG.3- TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS




FIG.4- TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE




FIG.5- REVERSE RECOVERY TIME CHARACTERISTIC AND TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM
